Summer Bills

It's common for summer water bills to be higher than winter bills, due to regular watering. Water is billed in tiered rates, so when you use less, you pay less. With careful management of your irrigation system and watering schedule, you can maintain a healthy landscape and lower bill. If you have concerns we can run a meter data profile to show when water is running through the meter and how much you use each time you water.

Lawn Tips

Water in morning or late evening when temperatures are cooler. Water long enough to moisten the soil 6" deep which is the depth of a healthy root system.

Adjust the sprinkler so only your lawn is watered and not the sidewalk or street.

Split your watering time into shorter periods to allow for better absorption.

Adjust your lawn mower to a higher setting. A taller lawn shades roots and maintains moisture longer.

Pot Holes

If you notice a pothole please report it to El Paso County so they can get it fixed. Completing the request on-line is the fastest way and it allows you to track the progress.
