to a bad cable. They are pumping 24 hours to keep up with usage while there are 2 wells down. There is high sewer and will monitor the neighborhoods. Hazy morning area seems to have higher flow and will be monitored in the manhole covers. Parks have been busy with all the rain. It is daily work to keep up with weeds. The air conditioning in the water plant is out and will be fixed soon.
