Our staff has been busy and has upgraded over a third of your 1,131 meters. There is no additional charge for this service and will result in benefits to you. The efficiency of reading the meter will be increased and you will be able to log on <https://eyeonwater.com> to verify your usage and identify potential leaks once your upgrade has been completed.

It is imperative that ALL property owners and property managers advise their renters of this situation so their meters can be replaced. If this is not done, there will be an added cost in the near future to read outdated water meters and very likely the disconnection of water service until the meter transmitters are replaced. Please help us avoid that situation. Thank you.

Little Libraries

The concept of “Little Free Libraries” is “Take a Book, Share a Book”. It is the exchanging of literature among neighbors. There are now three Little Libraries in CCMD area. The first was established by Cuchares Ranch HOA and is located on the east side of Wild Daisey Drive, a block and a half from Drennan Road. The second was donated by The Wodells and is located on the east side of Gunbarrel Drive near Pony Gulch Way. The third was provided by the Security Public Library and is located on public land on the east side of Anvil Drive near the Centre Court Park. One in Parkview Park on Horizonview drive, and another in Mosko Park on Hazy Morning Drive will soon be placed by the Security Public Library.

Books have been supplied by our neighbors and by the Security Public Library. Susan Garrett of the library has agreed to sponsor these Little Libraries, and some future ones. They will be routinely checked, and the supply of books rotated. Stewards for these sites will be recruited to monitor the boxes and contents.
