There are still Wildfire Mitigation packets available in the office on a first come first serve basis.

DID YOU KNOW? Colorado Centre Fire Department has an average response time of 3.5 minutes to your emergency. Even sooner if you live close to our station. These times are CRITICAL for emergencies that require rapid care like extreme bleeding, difficulty breathing, cardiac arrest, stroke, home structure fires, traffic accidents, and grass fires. In those situations and more, seconds count! Your next closest fire station for response is over 7 miles away with a likely response time of over 10 minutes. We are proud to be your neighborhood Fire Station!

811 is the phone number you call before digging to protect yourself and others from unintentionally hitting underground utility lines. There are millions of miles of buried utilities beneath the surface of the earth that are vital to everyday living like water, electricity, and natural gas. When you make the free call to 811 a few days before you dig, you will help prevent unintended consequences such as injury to you or your family, damage to your property, utility service outages to the entire neighborhood and potential fines and repair costs.
