SCOOP THE POOP!

SIGN UP FOR E-BILLS

Each month CCMD mails around 550 paper bills. USPS trucks these bills to Denver for sorting, then back to Colorado Centre for delivery. Paperless billing is not only more time efficient, but also conserves fossil fuels and decreases greenhouse gases. The paper production process consumes fresh water for growing trees and creates billions of gallons of wastewater in processing trees into paper. Paper billing costs the district money for paper, ink, envelopes, and stamps, as well as the time it takes to fold, stuff, and seal envelopes. Avoid this waste today by signing up for e-bills.
