
Water Pressure Regulators

We get a lot of calls from our residents about water pressure problems inside the home. CCMD maintains a relatively constant pressure of about 95 psi in our water system by utilizing pumps and the gravity fed water storage tank. This pressure is high enough to cause damage to pipes and fixtures inside the home, therefore a pressure reducing valve (PRV) is required by the district for all residences.

A PRV is designed to limit water pressure inside the home to a much safer ~ 50-60 psi. They are adjustable and some choose to limit the pressure even more to conserve water and save money.

A failing PRV is the main cause of fluctuating or loss of pressure inside the home. PRVs have a typical lifespan of 5-15 years and like any other appliance, are the property owner's responsibility to purchase, install, adjust, and maintain.

Signs of a failing PRV are: 1) diminishing or fluctuating water pressure, 2) no water pressure, 3) thumping, banging, hammering, or vibrating noises in the walls, 4) high water pressure or water leaking from faucets or a constant running toilet.
