2024 RESIDENTIAL WATER, WASTEWATER, STREET LIGHTS, FIRST RESPONDER, AND TRASH CHARGES

Water:

\$19.60 Per Month-Administrative Service Charge \$3.50 Per Month-Capital Improvement Service Charge

Tier 1: \$3.90 Per 1,000 Gallons-Use Charge up to 7.5kgal Tier 2: \$5.60 Per 1,000 Gallons-After 7.5kgal up to 15kgal

Tier 3: \$7.50 Per 1,000 Gallons-After 15kgal up to 20kgal

Tier 4: \$12.50 Per 1,000 Gallons-After 20kgal up to 25kgal

Tier 5: \$18.75 Per 1,000 Gallons-After 25kgal

Streetlights:

\$2.50 Per Month Service Charge

Trash Removal:

\$17.50 Per Month Service Charge

First Responder Services:

\$19.71 Per Month Service Charge

Wastewater (Sewer):

\$12.96 Per Month-Administrative Service Charge \$3.50 Per Month-Capital Improvement Service Charge \$8.06 Per Thousand (1000) Gallons-Use Charge
