You may have been wondering about all the activities taking place along Bradley Rd. After Bradley Heights subdivision began construction, the water supplies to the south we constructed. That was followed by the installation of a 24" water transmission line owned by Colorado Springs Utilities to serve Bradley Heights. Bradley Heights plans to be disconnected from the Colorado Centre system by the end of October of this year, if all goes well. That timeline created the need to construct a sewer metering station at the intersection of Bradley Road and Horizonview Drive. This metering station will be owned by the District after it is completed. After all this work is completed, the District will no longer serve interim customers.

There are also the improvements to the Fire Station which are scheduled to be completed sometime in November. These were required by the agreement that the District has with the Colorado Springs Fire Department.

The District will also replace the water valves at the intersection of Bradley Road and Horizonview Drive by the end of October. The connection of the Harris' Buildings to the 10" water line at Aerospace Blvd is also being modified so that the supply will be just from the Foreign Trade Zone main side. Other miscellaneous patch and valve work is also being undertaken in various locations throughout the District.

El Paso County will be working on drainage issues along Levi Ln. and some other areas in the District. Road repair for the District is scheduled but at present we do not have a timeline.
