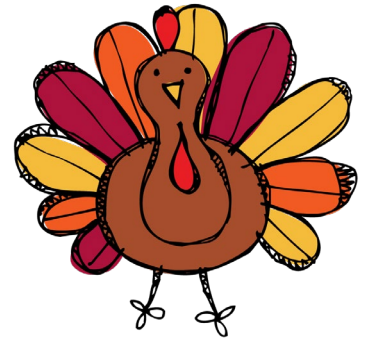

Sewer Calculation Period Reminder

The sewer calculation period is from December 1st, 2025 through January 31st, 2026. The usage during these two months determines your average sewer calculation for the next 12 months of billing. FOG

Fats, Oils, Grease

Friendly reminder: do not pour fats, oils, and grease down the drain. When these substances are poured down the drain, they can build up on the inside of sewer pipes, eventually causing a blockage that requires calling a plumber for services like drain cleaning, hydro jetting, sewer pipe descaling or worst-case scenario, a broken pipe repair. As more wastewater is sent down the line, it puts pressure on the blockage, leading to a backup. In some cases, the blockage can be severe enough to cause an overflow, spilling sewage onto the ground or into homes and businesses. Some common substances that contain fats, oils, or grease:

Cooking oil, Butter, Lard, Bacon Grease, Food scraps, Gravy, Sauces
